that importing and exporting plant and animal species included in CITES, as well as their parts and products, without a CITES permit is illegal and punishable by law

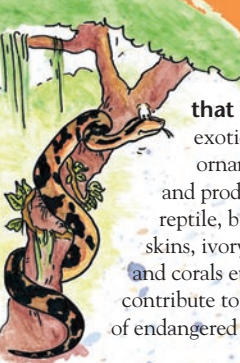
